SUGANDHASREE AWARD

The award which is given away biannually is instituted to recognize farmer's innovation in spices crops for enhanced income with sustainability in India. The award carries a citation and cash prize of Rs. 5,000/-. Any farmer who has been actively involved himself/herself in spices cultivation would be considered for the award.

Individuals who are interested to apply for the award are required to send their applications highlighting the significance and contribution to the field of spices research. The nomination should be sent through the concerned State Agricultural University/ICAR Institutes/Spices Board/State Agricultural/ Horticultural Departments certifying the authenticity of the innovation.

The application together with appropriate certificate should be sent to Secretary, Indian Society for Spices. The application submitted would be judged by a panel of experts whose recommendations would be considered by the executive committee for the award which would be final.

The award would be presented at the General Body Meeting of the Society.

The last date for receipt of applications is 10st November 2024
